DVLA forms for HGV minimum standards have changed. Advise applicant that unless they have perfect 6/6 vision in both eyes, they need to be seen by optician for eye testing prior to GP appt. Optician will complete visual testing part of the form, and this must be evident when attending GP appt. The charge for completing forms is the same, other than for those pts that believe they have 6/6 perfect vision and want the GP to test their vision.
